



Important Update on Pediatric Vaccination Policy 10-1-24

Attention Patients:

At Collaborative Health Pediatrics & CVFP Medical Group, our commitment to the health and well-being of our pediatric patients remains our top priority. Effective October 1, 2024, we have a new minimum vaccine requirement for establishing pediatric patients.

To ensure the safety of all our patients and to promote community health, we will no longer be able to accept patients who opt out of vaccinations. However, we want to reassure you that our current patients who are unvaccinated and any new siblings born into these families will be grandfathered under the previous policy and will not be required to adhere to the new guidelines. Please note the Vitamin K injection is not a vaccine and is required for all new patients, to include new children of currently established families.

For all newly establishing patients, we will require adherence to a minimum vaccine schedule for acceptance into our practice. This decision was made after careful consideration and is aimed at protecting the health of all children in our care.

We understand that this may raise questions and concerns, and we want to approach this change with compassion and support. If you choose to opt out of vaccinations, we are here to assist you in finding alternative care centers that accept non-vaccinated patients. Our goal is to provide your family with the best possible resources for your child’s health needs.

CHP MINIMUM VACCINE REQUIREMENTS

By 1 year	By 2 years	By 4 years	5+ years
1 DTaP 1 Hib 1 PCV20	2 DTaP 2 Hib 2 PCV20 1 IPV	3 DTaP 2 Hib 2 PCV20 1 IPV 1 MMR	3 DTaP 1 IPV 1 MMR

DTaP: Diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis; Hib: Haemophilus influenzae type b; PCV20: Pneumococcal conjugate; IPV: Inactivated poliovirus; MMR: Measles, mumps, rubella / For children aged 5 years and older, there is no requirement for Hib or PCV20 vaccines.

*** New policy will apply to new children of established adult patients.**
*** The Vitamin K injection is required for all new patients to include new children of currently established families.**
